Some useful things for people to know before going on this trip:

- Yes! You are safe in Mexico City on this tour with your group and guide. Stay with your group and safeguard your valuables. As in any tourist area, pickpockets are out there.
- Yes! It is safe to shower and brush your teeth with the water in Mexico City. A 2015 law requires all public restaurants and hotels to use filtered or bottled water for water service and ice. Here is a good-natured article on potable water in Mexico City: [Water in Mexico](#)
- No adapter or voltage converter is needed for your electronics.
- Mexico City is at a high altitude. Get physically prepared for your pilgrimage by walking and being well hydrated.
- The currency in Mexico is the peso, however USD, Visa and MasterCard are widely accepted.
- One carry-on bag and one personal item such as the Catholic Journeys backpack are included on the flights. The airlines do not consider travel from the US to Mexico and Canada to be international, therefore they will charge you to check luggage. This is not included in the pilgrimage price, as many people don't check a bag for this 6-day trip. If you want to check a bag, you can pay the airline directly when you check-in at the airport.
